- **Beads and glitter can be problematic** — Inferior beads may dissolve or bleed dye onto the fabric, while glued-on glitter is likely to shed during washing or drycleaning.

- **If you experience problems, return the garment to the retailer** — Reputable stores should have a fair policy for handling concerns with delicate, embellished items.
