



Dry Cleaning and Laundry Industry Award 2020

Laundry Only

As advised wage rates and all work related allowances in the Dry Cleaning and Laundry Industry Award 2020 (the Award) increase from the first full pay period commencing on or after 1 July 2025. In addition, some expense related allowances may also increase.

The increases in minimum wages and work-related allowances are the result of the 3.5% adjustment to minimum weekly wages awarded by the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) in the Annual Wage Review 2025.

The DIA is affiliated with the Australian Federation of Employers and Industries (AFEI).

The AFEI scheduled is included in this Award update providing a very comprehensive listing of wage rates at all levels together with casual employment and allowances.
